Built over two weeks, the 364-foot bridge now provides year-round, safe access to schools, health care and markets for the Murambi, Shyembe and Nyamugari communities—where seasonal river crossings once posed serious risks. B2R Farms combats food insecurity by teaching sustainable agriculture practices that empower small-scale farmers to prosper using the resources they have. 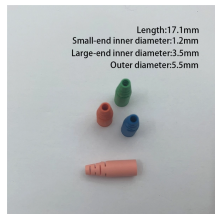
