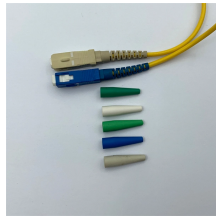

Metal cable tray systems for power communications cabling shall be installed in accordance with NECA/NEMA 105, Standard for Installing Metal Cable Tray Systems (ANSI).
