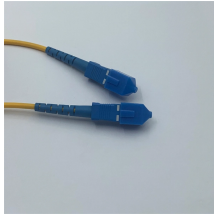

Stacking materials safely is essential to preventing accidents on-site or in a warehouse, and it's not as straightforward as piling boxes. With the right approach, you can keep both your team...



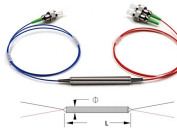
No sundries shall be piled around the distribution box, whether the metal fence is damaged, and whether the protective ground wire of the metal fence is firmly crimped.
