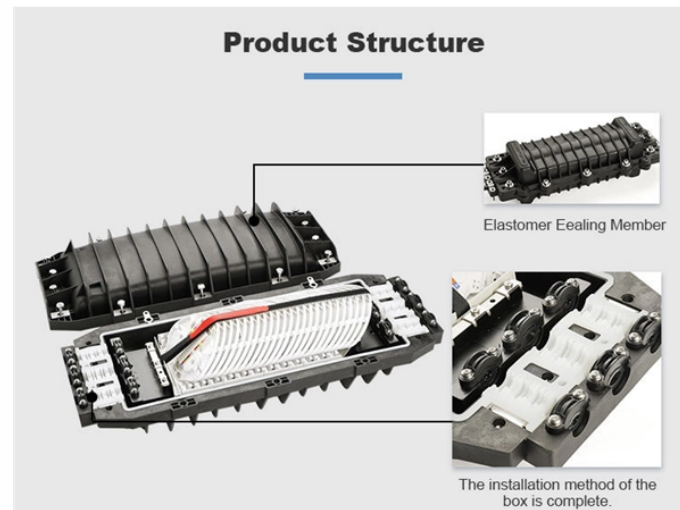


Drawer Cabinet Wiring Numbering Pattern



Overview

This standard describes requirements for numbering and labeling of real property electrical distribution equipment, circuits, and site lighting at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. Understanding the numbering system for electrical wires is a critical part of being able to understand the symbols and diagrams used in electrical designs. Everything is arranged according to functions, so each function has a unique name, i. "K1", "K2", "G1", etc. That means that every single wire can be identified in. Purpose – This Article is about all electrical equipment numbering system, Electrical Panel Numbering System, Electrical Wire Numbering System, Electrical Relay Numbering System, Electrical Drawing Numbering System, Electrical Schematic Numbering System, Electrical Cable Numbering Systems.

Drawer Cabinet Wiring Numbering Pattern



Each panelboard is considered a main and takes the number switchgear appended by the feeder number and a sequential letter (e.g., A, B, C); in this case, 65A1A and 65A1B.



The wire number must mark both the "wire number" and "terminal number" to facilitate cross-circuit tracing: Numbering Format: "Wire Number + - + Terminal Block Number"



Basing a wire number on a page of the wiring diagram would have to assume that the wiring diagram will never change and that the wire is only represented on one page.



This is an example of electrical wiring diagram about a wiring numbering system. Some type of "wire identification" is required to correctly connect the control circuit conductors to their ...



Each circuit fed from or incoming to an L.V. or H.V. switchboard, or L.V. MCC, shall be given a PC reference number, prefixed by the Electrical Identification Number of the equipment. See the ...



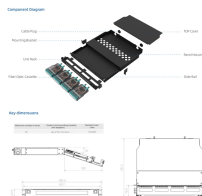
Each drawing will show the one wire in a different sheet # / row #. If separate control panels are part of a larger system, I just assign different page numbers for the individual enclosures. ...

All electrical components and wires inside and outside the control cabinet must have numbers that match those on the electrical schematic diagram. This consistency is crucial for ...



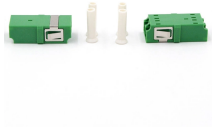
By comparing the wire numbers in the actual distribution cabinet with those on the wiring diagram, the uses and directions of the wires can be quickly and accurately determined.
