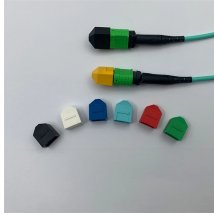

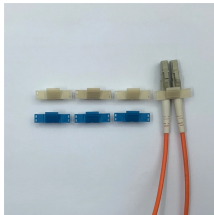

I use a thin bead of silicone between the glass and door frame rabbet to prevent rattles. The glass is secured with thin batons of the same wood as the door and mitred on the corners for a ...

I used the crystal clear silicone, not the milky bathroom stuff, when putting "falling water" patterned glass in my built-in kitchen china cabinet. Just lay down a tiny continuous bead on the ...



A step up would be to use the plastic spline made for this purpose. A third way, perhaps the best, is to make wood stops that miter together and tack or glue into place. An older method would be glazier's ...



Glass is a non-porous surface, so a glue such as epoxy would be better suited to the task. Wood glue is a good option if you don't have any epoxy on hand, but it has the potential to ...
