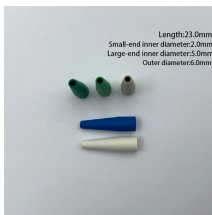
Ladder Cable Tray systems consists of two longitudinal side members connected by individual transverse members, and is designed for use as a power cable or control cable support system.
