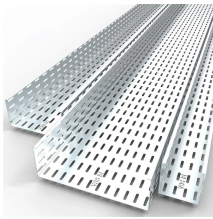

How to delete a zone on a fiber optic switch



1. Firstly we need to know the specific names of the Zones that we intend to delete. To gather the full list of zone members within a Zoneset run `show zoneset vsan xx`. The output will ...



Working with zones: 1. Create a zone: `zonecreate "name", "member [; member...]"` Members can be aliases, ports, or WWN addresses. 2. Adding new members to the zone: `zoneadd ...`



Hence, switches are segmented due to zone conflict `cfg mismatch`. If the content difference is small, you can manually add, delete, or modify the config differences using `zone` or `alias` commands. But in ...



Use this command to remove one or more members from an existing zone, and to remove one or more members or principal members from a Peer Zone. If all members are removed, the zone is deleted. If ...



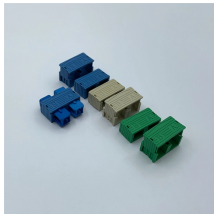
