Connect one inline between your solar panel and charge controller and it'll measure voltage, current, wattage, and more. Here's how to use one. Your multimeter is your best friend when testing solar panels. You can use it to check: 1. Open circuit voltage (Voc) 2. Short circuit current (Isc) 3. Current at max power (Imp) Here's how: A clamp meter, sometimes called an ammeter, can measure the level of current flowing through a wire. You can use one to check whether or not your solar panels are outputting their expected number of amps. A clamp meter makes solar panel testing incredibly quick and convenient because you don't have to disconnect your panels in order to check them. If your solar panel isn't outputting as much power as you expect, first do the following: 1. Make sure the panel is in direct sunlight and is facing and angled toward the sun 2. Check that no part of the panel is in shade 3. Clean the solar panel if it's dirty 4. Make sure there are no clouds or haze blocking the sun. Even thin cloud coverage can r.

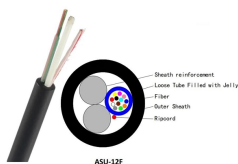
