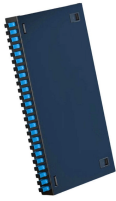
Yes, removing electrical panel covers is essential for effective thermal imaging. It allows detection of issues like poor connections that are invisible through solid enclosures.

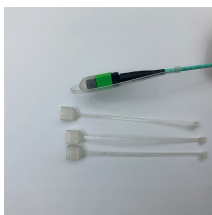
