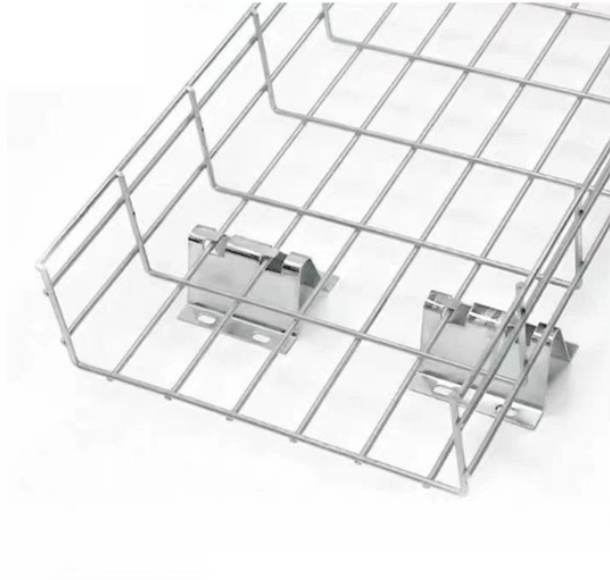


How to remove the wall mount on the distribution box

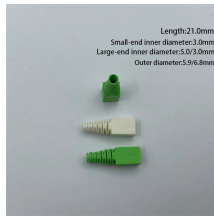
