## How to use a ceramic insert glue scraper



The WoodRiver® Mini Glue Scraper makes removing excess glue squeeze-out or small areas of old finish easy and efficient. This pull style scraper uses a square or radius carbide insert ...



After removal, use the chisel and scraper to meticulously clean the recess, removing all traces of old adhesive, grout, or sealant to create a clean, flat surface for the new insert. Selecting a new insert ...



Always start with a plastic scraper or old credit card to remove softened glue. Hold the scraper at a low angle and use controlled, even pressure to avoid chipping tile edges.



Resins or some kind of adhesive are used on most guides to fix the ceramic in place and this needs to be scraped away. I used a deburring tool on the guide and a stanley blade on the ...



I banged a guide on something which slightly bent the hoop, and the insert popped out. Pressing it back by hand this is as far as it wants to go without feeling like I'm going to break it.



Just use a heat gun to gently soften the glue behind the insert and use a leather glove to work it back and forth until it spins inside the bezel. Then take some Gorilla Duct tape placed over ...



How to glue ceramic together can be a rewarding and sustainable practice. Throughout this guide, we've emphasized the importance of careful preparation, precise adhesive application, ...



Start by scraping away as much of the adhesive as possible using a scraper or chisel. Once the adhesive is softened, use a scraper or putty knife to gently lift and scrape off the adhesive.



This is a ceramic bezel insert, and they will break and shatter quite easily if too much force is applied. The tape remained intact and could be pulled off easily with tweezers, and the remainder of the adhesive, ...



Our ceramic blades are so hard that they can scratch glass, however, so it is important to test them on an inconspicuous area, to ensure you're being cautious and not applying too much pressure on the ...
