

Illustrated steps for wiring fiber optic cable junction boxes



Overview

Learn how to install a fiber optic termination box step-by-step for FTTH projects. Covers mounting, splicing, routing, labeling, and testing for indoor/outdoor use. Be sure of enough length insert(s) from the cable gland outlet(s). This must be done prior to needed for insertion into Terminal Blocks. NOTE - wire lengths will vary depending on size and tighten screws. Fiber Protection: Prevents damage to the fiber strands from any kind of bending, dust, or unintentional handling. Easy Maintenance: Enables technicians to access. In general, installing the optical fiber distribution box can be divided into three steps: installing the optical fiber distribution box on the rack, introducing the optical cable into the optical fiber distribution box, and planning the optical fiber path in the optical fiber distribution box. Compared to conventional copper cables, fiber optic cables offer a significantly higher bandwidth and are less susceptible to interference.

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Use only shielded cable. Temperatures at the cable entry can reach 80° C. Selection of cable must be appropriate for the ambient temperature range in which the product is used.



The outdoor optical fiber cable is connected to the terminal box. The purpose is to fuse the optical fiber and the pigtail in the optical cable, and lead it out through a jumper.
