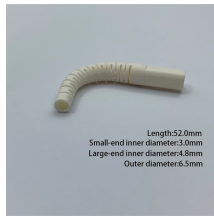


Overview

When a company or individual carries out fiber optic work on your property without your consent, it may be considered trespassing or a violation of property rights. Internet Service Providers (ISPs) often face significant challenges related to Right of Way (ROW) when deploying fiber optic infrastructure or expanding their fiber networks. ROW refers to the legal right to install infrastructure (like fiber optic cables, utility poles, towers, and equipment) on. Utility boxes are integral components of the infrastructure that delivers essential services, including electrical transformers, gas meters, water meters, and telecommunications equipment. The rule applies to certain antennas, including direct-to-home satellite dishes that are less than. The Committee on National Security Systems (CNSS) issues this Instruction pursuant to its authority under National Security Directive 42, National Policy for the Security of National Security Telecommunications and Information Systems. 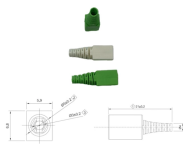
In some cases, incumbent service providers may already have ROW agreements in place, making it difficult for new ISPs to gain access. These incumbents may try to block competitors ...
