

National Standard for Galvanizing Process of Cable Trays

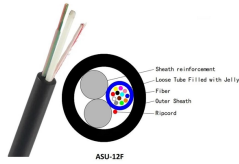


Overview

Process: Deposits a layer of zinc onto the steel surface through electrolysis.
Primary Standard: Specified in GB/T 26941. 1-2011 "Cable Trays - Part 1: General. It is the first joint effort of NEMA and CSA International to put in one place standards for metal trays per both NEMA and CSA methods. Information on maintenance and system modification is also. Characteristics: The zinc layer is thin, bright, and. , is a welded wire-mesh cable management system made of high-strength steel wire.



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Cable tray length is selected based on the load to be supported, the distance between the supports (also referred to as the span), and handling and installation constraints.

The galvanization process is the primary anti-corrosion treatment for cable trays. The quality of the zinc coating directly determines the tray's service life and application scenarios.



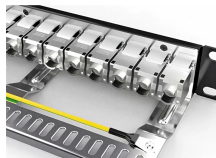
