

Preservation of Optical Cable Goods



Overview

- If Optical Fibre cable is to be stored for longer than approximately four weeks then it is recommended that cable ends are appropriately sealed. (Heat shrink cable end caps are recommended). The following recommended procedures will assure that the same high quality of the bulk cable received is maintained after the cable is stocked, cut and/or shipped.



If cables are terminated, spliced, or installed under a cold weather condition, it is recommended to place cables in a heated storage for at least 24 hours before cable preparation or installation to minimize ...



Indoor LAN copper and OF cables are not waterproof and their jacket is not UV resistant. In no circumstances shall any indoor cable boxes or reels be stored out-side or in a harsh environment. ...

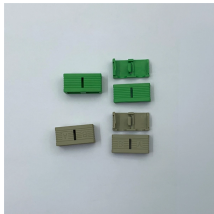
