

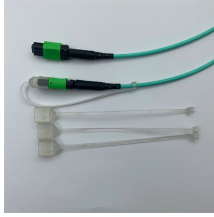
Price of bricklaying at bridge arch openings

Any piers (columns) with more than 4 bricks per course will be charged as an extra. 00 per brick flat rate except for block work piers.
