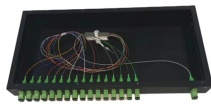
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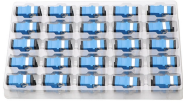

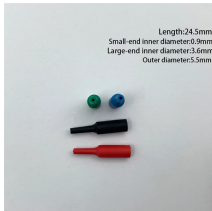

Once you have the total cable area, divide it by the tray's usable area and multiply the result by 100 to get the percentage. According to NEC Article 392, the fill is generally limited to 40% ...



Cable tray length is selected based on the load to be supported, the distance between the supports (also referred to as the span), and handling and installation constraints.



Powder coated tray requires the removal of the coating in the clamping area in order to create a bond. Cable tray should be bonded to the building or facility grounding system every 50" - 60".
