

## Router indicator turns red after fiber optic cable repair



### Overview

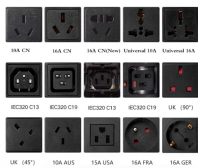
The LOS steady or blinking red light indicates any of the following reasons below. Fiber cable bend (from NAP box or pole going to your modem). However, when it blinks red or stays solid red, it signifies a Loss of Signal, a problem preventing your router from communicating. A red light on your router can be a source of frustration and confusion. Fortunately, diagnosing and resolving these issues doesn't have to be complicated. Before you panic or call tech support, there are several simple fixes you can try at home that often solve this problem in minutes.



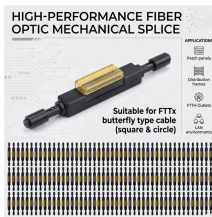

A red light on a router usually means the device has lost its internet connection or is experiencing a hardware issue. First, check whether your modem is also showing abnormal lights.



If the cable is loose or in the wrong port, the router will power up but show a red status light because it can't detect the internet signal. Next, restart both the fiber terminal and the router to re-establish ...

The light indicator means loss of signal, fiber optic cable not properly connected to the modem, damage cable, and ISP network problem. You may need to contact your internet service ...



A red light on your modem typically means it can't detect an internet signal and can't connect. To fix this issue, you'll need to go through several troubleshooting steps.



"LOS" means "Loss of Signal", which means the high tech blinky light on the ISP end of the fiber stopped blinking, or the glass in between you and the blinky light is busted somewhere.



Ensure your Fiber Jack is connected to the network and the LED lights are connected and working properly before moving on to troubleshoot your router. Likewise, your router will have to be ...
