

Turkmenistan's distribution boxes lack protective covers



Overview

Turkmenistan does not have company disclosure requirements and companies in most cases do not publish their annual financial statements. The procurement of equipment, spare parts, and consumables for Turkmenistan's major industries, such as oil and gas, power generation, railway, air transportation, and telecommunications is state controlled. Turkmenistan is a landlocked country in Central Asia, bordered by Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan to the north, Afghanistan to the southeast, Iran to the south and southwest, and the Caspian Sea to the west. It is one of six independent Turkic states.

Ashgabat is the capital and largest city. 9 million, but there is evidence that it has. In 2022, Reporters without Borders ranked Turkmenistan 177th of the 180 countries it covers. Estimates of the population with internet access are low and many sites are blocked.

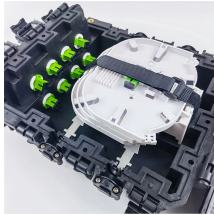
