Overview

The consortium, co-led by Singtel and China Telecom Global Limited (CTG), comprises four other regional carriers - China Telecommunications Corporation (CTC), Globe Telecom, Inc. (Globe) and DITO Telecommunity Corporation (DITO) of the Philippines, and Unified National Networks. 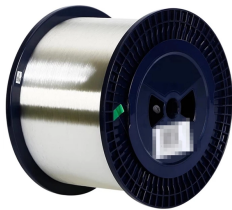

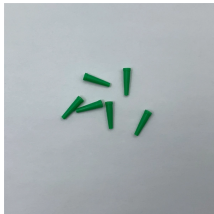
