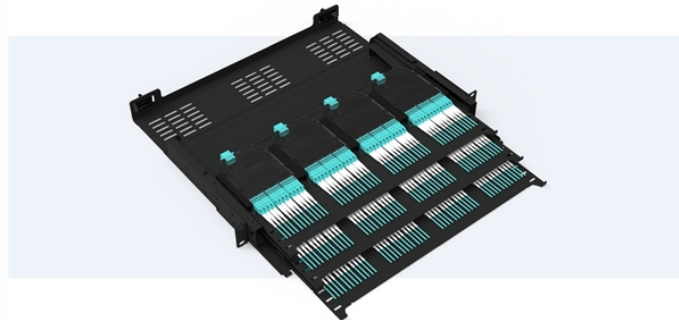

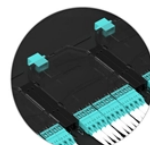

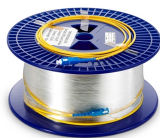
In order to save power within the module, optical modules have been made that used the digital interface definition, such as the CEI, but without retiming the signals within the module.
